Through the success of our men's center the lives of men have been changed given new hope and help for a better life. They have gone out from our men's shelter to be re-established with wives, children, family, and friends who love them.

Thanks be to our God and to you, our donors for **To the future:** We have talked and planned over the past 1 1/2 years regarding a women's shelter program for the prostitutes who come to us for help. The Lord seems to be opening a door for us to move forwards. **We feel now is time for us to act.**

We believe God is leading us to work in the thought of Isaiah 61:1 "... he hath sent me to bind up the broken-hearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening [of the prison] to them that are bound;"

Look into the future with me. Can you see them? Women once bound by the ravages of sin and the cruelty of those who control them and use them, set free from their prison, now free to live as God has called them to live with hearts, minds and emotions healed from the trauma of abuse

We believe the Lord has called us to be advocates for their release, to see their chains broken and their broken hearts healed.

This will not be an easy task. Nor are there any quick fixes. However, the vision stated above will unfold and be accomplished as you pray and continue to give, helping us find others who would like to help, especially with the women caught in human trafficking and prostitutions.



We must find and hire the right woman to be our director and then see that she has appropriate training for the task at hand. From there a well thought out plan must be developed with appropriate staffing to make the program work.

A secure facility will be found in which we can house those who come to us seeking help.

This will take time, diligence wisdom and the leading of the Lord to set all this in motion.

First, we need your prayers. The women we are becoming advocates for are deeply entrenched in sin and held captive by an enemy



that does not want to see them restored.

We know our God is greater than all this but we recognize this is first and foremost a spiritual battle.

Secondly, we need to finances to hire, train and equip a women's director.

Thirdly, we will need to find and lease a secure facility. Because of the nature of this work, there are dangers for which we must be very wise.

Fourth, we are looking for those who would advocate for these ladies in the area where you live.

Prostitution and human trafficking are tragedies in society worldwide. Israel is no exception.

I have seen these women, right in front of me where we provide meals. Some who are no longer useful to anyone may be 35 yet they look as if they are 70. Drugs and alcohol and the trauma of years of abuse by those who control them and those who use them leaves them in a prison few people know of or understand.



Our men's program is operating very well as we said at the beginning of this newsletter. That program will continue and grow. Our women's program is new and just being established. **We need your help.**
